 - Mr. Davis – Due to new District recruitment strategy there will be many more students attending.

 - Plus we will have Bernardo Yorba students with us in the stands. We will have our regular student zone but a lot of bodies. Could use help “herding” – many hands make light work. This is the first night that we will be doing the show for real. **We would really appreciate more help.**
