If it gets cancelled due to Covid, we would be able to get refunds. WGASC-schedule is still on for the spring. Percussion circuit is still virtual for now. We will be doing a lot of rehearsing. Marching band until Thanksgiving, then Holiday Music. Students will be able to use cubbies in band room and can not share. Covid covers all the time. One way entrance/exit in the band room. Zero Period starts at 6:58, on the field. Arivial time will be sooner, give plenty of time to put things away in a socially distant manner and get out to the field by call time. If the students are on Zoom for zero period, they will now start at 6:58. Mr. Turner will be on site at the school, making sure zoom runs smoothly.
