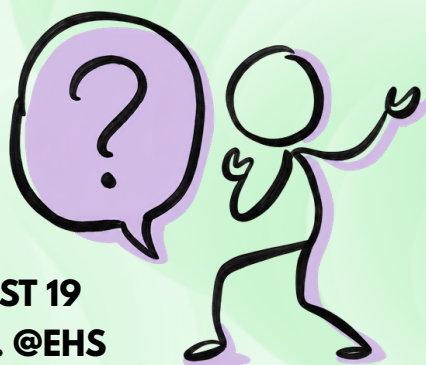

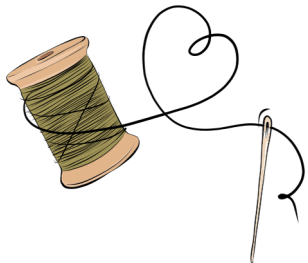

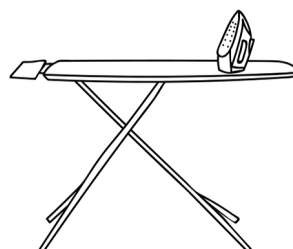

FOOTBALL GAMES WHAT TO EXPECT

- *Chaperones, roadies, tow drivers and students arrive between 5-5:30 p.m. Call times vary depending on role. Seat cover assistants go directly to YLHS.*
- *Departure is typically at 5:45. Game time is always 7. Return time usually 9:30-10.*
- *First quarter and part of the second is spent as pep band in the stands, then sections warm up for halftime performance. Third quarter is a break. Fourth is more pep band playing. We position ourselves on the home side to the left of the 50-yard line.*
